A message from Jason Watson, Chairman at UAW Local 2164...

Due to the recent announcements by GM through Mary Barra, our future and job security is being threatened! It is very disheartening that for many years prior to now, GM has chosen to build vehicles in countries other than the US! However, and all along, GM has also built many quality vehicles HERE in the USA; built by hard working UAW members.

Earlier this year, GM unveiled and announced it would bring back and build the Chevy Blazer...IN MEXICO. And now, just a short time after, GM is stating that multiple facilities may not have future product allocated to those plants. GM is not stating that these plants will close but at this point, do not have known product that is going to be built there – still a huge disappointment! The UAW facilities impacted are Lordstown, OH Assembly, Detroit Hamtramck, Warren Transmission and Baltimore Operations. And let's not forget our UNIFOR brothers and sisters at Oshawa, Ont. Assembly.

This is a direct slap in the face to all of us that work very hard, make many sacrifices, and are loyal consumers of the products that we build.

Aside from the fact that these important discussions will be held during national negotiations between GM and the UAW next year, there is a cause I am asking your help with.
