Vote by Mail

Due to the Covid-19 Virus, I am urging all of our retirees to vote by mail this year. I know many of you have been doing that for years. **Here are some good reasons:**

- * **It's Reliable** - 39 states have some form of Vote by Mail. 5 states, vote exclusively by mail. Vote by Mail, and Absentee Voting is the same thing.
- * **It's Safe** - Vote from home, don't risk your health by going to the polls.
- * **It's Secure** - Mail your ballot, or drop it off at the Supervisor of Elections drop box.
- * **Avoid Long Lines** - Polling places could be changed, and lines could be hours long, due to a shortage of poll workers. Florida is already having trouble getting poll workers because of the pandemic. (most of them are seniors like us)
- * **You Can Track Your Ballot** - When you vote by mail, you can track your ballot on the Supervisor of Elections web site. You can tell when it is received, and when it is counted. (vote by mail ballots are counted before same day voting is counted)
